WHEREAS, the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is accepting applications for the Local Government Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Port of Cascade Locks desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing needed park and recreation acquisitions, improvements and enhancements; and

WHEREAS, Port of Cascade Locks Commissioners have identified Full Service Restroom improvements at the Marine Park East location as a high priority need in Cascade Locks and the Gorge; and

WHEREAS, the development of full-service restrooms are a critical need in the area; and

WHEREAS, the Port of Cascade Locks has available local matching funds to fulfill its share of obligation related to this grant application should the grant funds be awarded; and

WHEREAS, the Port of Cascade Locks will provide adequate funding for on-going operations and maintenance of this park and recreation facility should the grant funds be awarded;
