 - i. Crane reported that Artist Lanquist has submitted his first invoice to the Port.
 - ii. Berge had no updates.
 - iii. Stipan reported that representatives from Tidewater reached out to him and is also interested in participating.
 - b. Explore Celebration Possibilities
 - i. Klute proposed creating a task list to organize future efforts, distinguishing between tasks the Port can handle and those requiring external coordination. Committee members will be asked to provide input on this preliminary list, creating a living document with actionable tasks and timelines. Klute will take the initial action of drafting this document within the next week for review at the subsequent meeting.

AA Stocker reported that ED Blue addressed the City Council on the March 10th Council meeting. Crane added that the City Council was open for the committee to begin gathering community feedback. The committee discussed options for about cost and grant availability of restoring the existing one versus painting a new one. Berge and Crane noted more grant opportunities favor new murals and emphasized considering long-term maintenance in the project scope. Stipan gave a suggestion to involve the community in selecting the new mural design

through a public vote, potentially even securing sponsorship for a design competition. Klute stated that she will mention these ideas at the next Commission meeting.
